POSSIBLE OFFERINGS...on our radar! We are working on several IT offerings requested by our schools.

**IPTV - Internet Protocol TV** - We are investigating a hosted solution that could support districts who have interest in this area. Our first meeting is scheduled for next week to discuss product and infrastructure solution. Shortly afterwards, we will offer a demonstration of the product for your consideration.



**Hosted Backup Services** - We have been asked to look into developing storage options for schools who would like to utilize ACCESS as a backup site. If you have such an interest, we will work with you individually to determine your needs and provide a cost for this service.

**Hosted Security Camera Service** - We have been asked to research and provide information to schools about a possible hosted security camera solution through ACCESS. Several schools have outdated security equipment in place needing refreshed. We are working with a company to evaluate the best way to approach this on behalf of our schools. Presently, two districts have permitted us to evaluate their needs and provide information. If you are interested in this venture, please let us know as well. A demonstration of the product is being scheduled for your review.

**Virtual Server Capacity** - ACCESS continues to provide virtual server capacity and backup for our schools. Before you purchase new server hardware, let us quote you space in our virtual server environment. Aa virtual server may save you money in the long run and free up having to purchase additional hardware.

**Virtual Cisco Wireless Controller** - During conversations with Cisco, we determined we may be able to offer virtual Cisco wireless controller space in our virtual environment. If you are currenting utilizing an "old" controller and wish to upgrade to something newer, we can virtualize your controller and host it for you. If your Access Points are of a newer model, you should be able to continue to utilize those devices. If this is of interest to you, please let us know so that we can work with you to see if we can provide this service at a cost savings.

Through a Management Council initiative, providing reduced costs, we have been able to purchase KnowBe4 materials for cybersecurity training and remediation. ## **Need Help?**

We ask that you email the team (rather than an individual) to ensure the most timely response; emailing an individual directly could delay our ability to assist you. Please make sure to include as many details as possible - the software in which you are working, school year, building, student name and ID, the specific screen on which you may be working, the exact error message you are receiving, step-by-step directions of your process, etc. Providing this information helps us help you!



#### **New Module in StudentInformation!**

On March 10th, we installed the 17.3.0 release which included the new **Student Absence Intervention** Plan needed for the HB410 requirements. This will aid districts in managing the needed components for intervention plans as well as maintaining the EMIS reportable elements. The new Student Absence Intervention screen has been added to the student Attendance menu.

From this screen, you can:

- ★ View a summary of the student's excessive absences, habitual truancies, and any thresholds the student has met
- ★ View the district's responsibilities
- ★ Create and update absence intervention information for the student
- ★ Print absence intervention letters

## **Standards Based Report Cards**

Now is the time to start planning updates or additions to your standards based report cards for the 2018-2019 school year. We would like to have open communication with your district and/or teacher leaders about changes or new report cards you might be considering. It's important to have these discussions within your district prior to meeting with ACCESS in the Spring. We will be scheduling times to meet with all standards based districts (or those considering) before the end of the school year. Please feel free to contact us if you have any questions about standards based report cards!



## **NEW Perfect Attendance Report**

A new report has been added The Analytics Hub to aid districts in determining students who have Perfect Attendance (missed zero hours of school). The report titled "Yearly Absence Detail with Perfect Attendance" will list all students and their absence information, with the last column showing Total Absence Hours. Users can either use Post Filtering to narrow down by building, or this report can be exported into Excel and filtered by building and Total Absence Hours.

- Student Days in Course Export Class List including number of days student was enrolled in the course-section
- Custom Student Export Create your own report that includes Students, Status, SSID, Grade level, Admission and Withdrawal dates

## Samegoal (IEP Anywhere)

Did you know that Samegoal (IEP Anywhere) is not for special education only? Districts have the ability to create, RIMPs, WEPs, WAPs, 504 Plans and EL plans from IEP Anywhere. If you'd like additional information, please send an email to student@access-k12.org.



ODE recently published <u>updated Special Education Forms</u>, revised December 2017 and February 2018. Districts are required to use these updated forms beginning Fall 2018 for the 2018-19 school year. These forms will be available July 1, 2018 (for districts that did not choose the Early Bird option of April 2, 2018).

This forms update will include:

- PR-02 Parent Invitation
- PR-05 Parent Consent for Evaluation
- PR-06 ETR

- PR-07 IEP
- PR-09 Services Plan
- OP-6A Progress Report

All NEW documents created in the system will use the updated forms after the form update. Any existing document already created will be unaffected, and remain in its original format. This is done so that existing information is not disrupted, and because in numerous places there is not a one-to-one mapping between forms.


Existing district and user-level banks will automatically copy into updated form fields where appropriate. All documents will continue to be viewable and editable in their original format. ODE has published extensive <u>universal support materials</u> for IDEA guidance. Many districts are using these support materials for training internally or attending a training performed by their SST.

## **Harmony Reports**

Harmony has been updated with a new look, two new reports, an update to the Assessment History Export, and new features. Harmony login is available at <a href="https://harmony.access-k12.org">https://harmony.access-k12.org</a>. You will use your existing StudentInformation username and password. If you need access, please complete the form found on our website under Student Services.

#### **New Features Include:**

- **Live Search:** A search box is on your home page and on dropdowns and tables. Results are displayed as you type.
- Saved Criteria: You can save your criteria on every report so that you can easily rerun that report again later.
- Your Account: A new page that displays your current user access, and allows you to view, remove and save report criteria you have created.



**Assessment History Export** - This report has been updated to include all assessments from the StudentInformation > Student > Assessment menu. The list of Student Assessments has been cleaned up on the selection page. In the output, the Grad Points Total column has been removed. The Grad Points column is still listed to display the individual Grad Points for each assessment.

**New Graduation Points Summary Report** - The new Graduation Points Summary report is available under the Graduation/Eligibility category. This report generates an Excel spreadsheet of your data from the StudentInformation > SIS > Student > Graduation Points > Grad Points Search page. Grade Level and Student Status filters are available when running the report.

This alert system is an opt-in service that is hosted at ACCESS through our partnership with TEC and will be used to notify you of network service disruptions, system outages, and maintenance reminders via text messages. ## **Google Team Drives**

Team Drives are shared spaces for teams to store their files in Google Drive and guarantee that every member has the most up-to-date information, no matter the time or place.

Team Drives files are **owned by the team members** (not an individual) and stay put exactly where they are even when a team member leaves the group or leaves your district.

## **Benefits**

- Team Drives is designed to centralize your shared files.
- Team Drives eliminates the issues with individual owners. Team Drives are designed to store the team's work collectively, so if a document's creator moves off the team or leaves your district, that document doesn't go with them.
- Team members are prevented from accidentally removing or deleting files that others need.
