# Network Services - Reminder

## Password Policy and Multifactor Authentication (MFA) Reminder

Passwords now need to be a minimum of 16 characters. They also need 3 of the 4 complexity rules, i.e., uppercase, lowercase, numbers, and symbols. Don't forget to turn on Google multifactor authentication to make your password never expire, not 90 days!

**Beginning December 1, 2025, MFA will be mandatory** for all Google Suite products. Click [HERE](#) for more information.

## HB96 CYBERSECURITY TRAINING REQUIREMENTS!



Under HB96, **annual** cybersecurity training requirements are now upon us in an effort to keep all systems secure and data safe. It's simple, important, and helps protect everyone.

At **no cost**, cybersecurity awareness training is available through TechGuard. To get started, simply submit a Help Desk ticket to ACCESS with number of staff to be licensed (be sure to include a small buffer) and you will be on your way to compliance!!

## STUDENT EMAIL PASSPHRASES ROTATION REMINDER!

Please ensure you are utilizing the randomly generate easy to remember passphrases for student email accounts instead of the current random jumble of letters and numbers and **refreshing these passwords/passphrases on an annual basis**. If you would like to make a change to the password format for your district, please submit a helpdesk request to [support@access-k12.org](mailto:support@access-k12.org) and let us know the desired format ie capitalized 3 letter word, random 2 digit number, lower case four letter word, special character (Red27test!). The format can even vary by grade level!

## IPDP Software Migration

Update on new IPDP software migrations

The new IPDP software has been released for those currently using the module in HR Kiosk.

As migrations take place, improvements and fixes **are being implemented** and will continue to be expected.

Districts will be migrated to the new platform from HR Kiosk prior to the December 31, 2025 cut off date when HR Kiosk use will cease.

ACCESS staff will continue working with each district individually to migrate data making the transition as easy as possible over the next few months.

## STUDENT SERVICES (con't)

### Students using Google credentials to log into ParentAccess

In order for students to login with these credentials, the Account Import in GradeBook > PA Admin will need to be ran to sync the student's email address from StudentInformation. This process populates the student's email address in the Issuer Email Claim field in PA Admin > ParentAccess Account Maintenance. **Don't forget to run this process frequently to sync new students!**

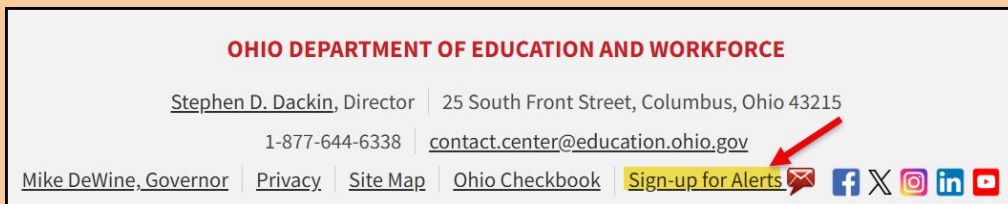

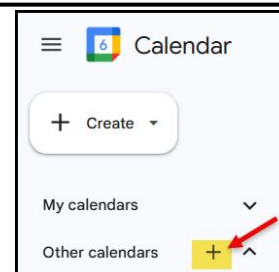

## FY25 Graduate and CCWMR Reporting closes Friday, October 10, 2025

The reporting of 2024-2025 Graduates and their College, Career, Workforce, and Military Readiness (CCWMR) data closes on **Friday, October 10, 2025**. This is a great time to review ODEW reports available in the Data Collector that include the GRAD-425 (4 year cohort), GRAD-524 (2024 grad cohort-5th year status) and the 2026\_RPTCRD\_CCWMRdy\_DETAIL\_xxxxxxx.xls reports.

FY25 Graduate and CCWMR data can also be viewed from your OH|ID > Reports Portal > Secure Data Center > Graduation tile. Select the report (tile) you would like to review. **This is the data that will be posted to your FY26 Local Report Card.**

## Federal Child Count

All special education events should be entered to StudentInformation and reported to ODEW as they take place.

The Federal Child Count uses the current (FY26) Beginning of Year Student (S) and prior (FY25) End of Year Student (S) collections, and is looking for all IEPs in place as of October 31, 2025.

The close date for reporting this data is December 19, 2025.

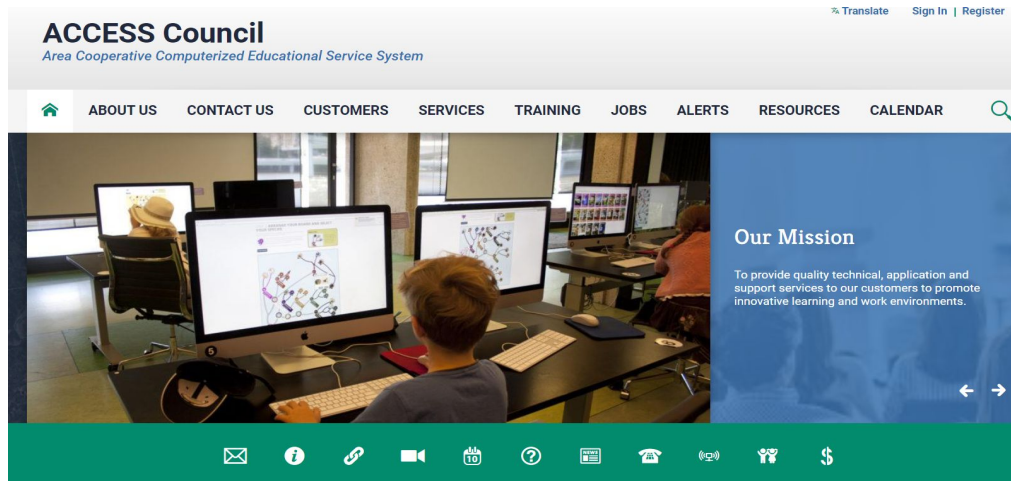
