

Adding an Individual Student to an Intervention

Adding a Student from the Student Interventions Screen

Method 1

In the row of the student for whom you want to add an intervention, hover your cursor until icons appear. Then, click .

The **Add Student Intervention** screen displays with the student's name in the **Student** field.

- On the General tab, select a Program from the drop-down list.
- 3 Select a **Tier** from the drop-down list.

Note: If a template is associated with the selected program and tier, the template displays automatically.

4 Select options for the Intervention Provider,
Referred By, Sessions per Week, and Minutes per
Session fields.

Note: Fields with an asterisk (*) must be completed and saved before you can edit the template fields.

- 5 Enter a Referral Date and a Start Date.
- 6 Click Save.
- 7 At the bottom of the screen, enter the necessary information.
- 8 Click Save.


Note: After you save an intervention, the **Attachments** tab is activated. If you want to add an attachment to an intervention, see the Adding and Managing Intervention Attachments instructional sheet.

Method 2


1 Click Add Intervention.

The Add Student Intervention screen displays.

- In the **Student** field, enter at least 3 characters of the first or last name of the student to whom you want to add an intervention.
- 3 When a list of students displays, select the student.
- 4 Repeat steps 2 through 8 from Method 1.












Adding a Student from the Student Roadmap Screen

1 On the **Students, Standards, Student Interventions, RIMPs, Graduation Points,** or **Multiple Measures** screens, click the name of the student to whom you want to add an intervention.




The Student Roadmap screen displays.

2 In the Interventions area, click Add an Intervention.
